

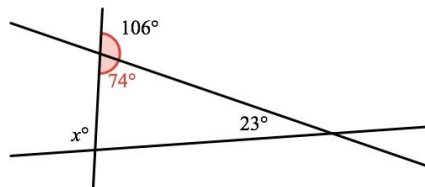
**Y6 Learning Journey**

**RE- *Vocation and Commitment***
